4 DAY, 1 NIGHT PADI OPEN WATER COURSE

The first step in learning to scuba dive is the PADI Open Water Diver course, the world's most recognised scuba diving qualification.

The most popular of our dive courses, this four-day one-night course begins with two days at our Cairns dive centre, learning theory and practising your scuba skills in our heated training pool. The last two days of the course will be conducted on the outer reef aboard our liveaboard vessel OceanQuest, where you will spend one night on the Great Barrier Reef.

On the reef, you will complete 4 training dives and 1 fun dive with your instructor to finish your certification, and between dives, you will have time to relax on the sun deck and chat with other divers. Meals are included and prepared by our talented on-board chefs.

Want to stay longer? Upgrade for additional nights from just \$325 per certified diver or \$220 per snorkeller based on twin share.

WHAT IS THE PADI OPEN WATER COURSE?

The first step in learning to scuba dive is the PADI Open Water Diver course. Our basic Open Water Diver course takes four days, with two days of classroom and pool time, and two days at sea. The course is divided into three parts: learning the theory, practising your scuba skills in our pool, and finally diving in open water on the Great Barrier Reef. Scan the QR code opposite and our Course Director will talk you through what is involved, prerequisites, what you will learn and why you should choose to learn with Divers Den.

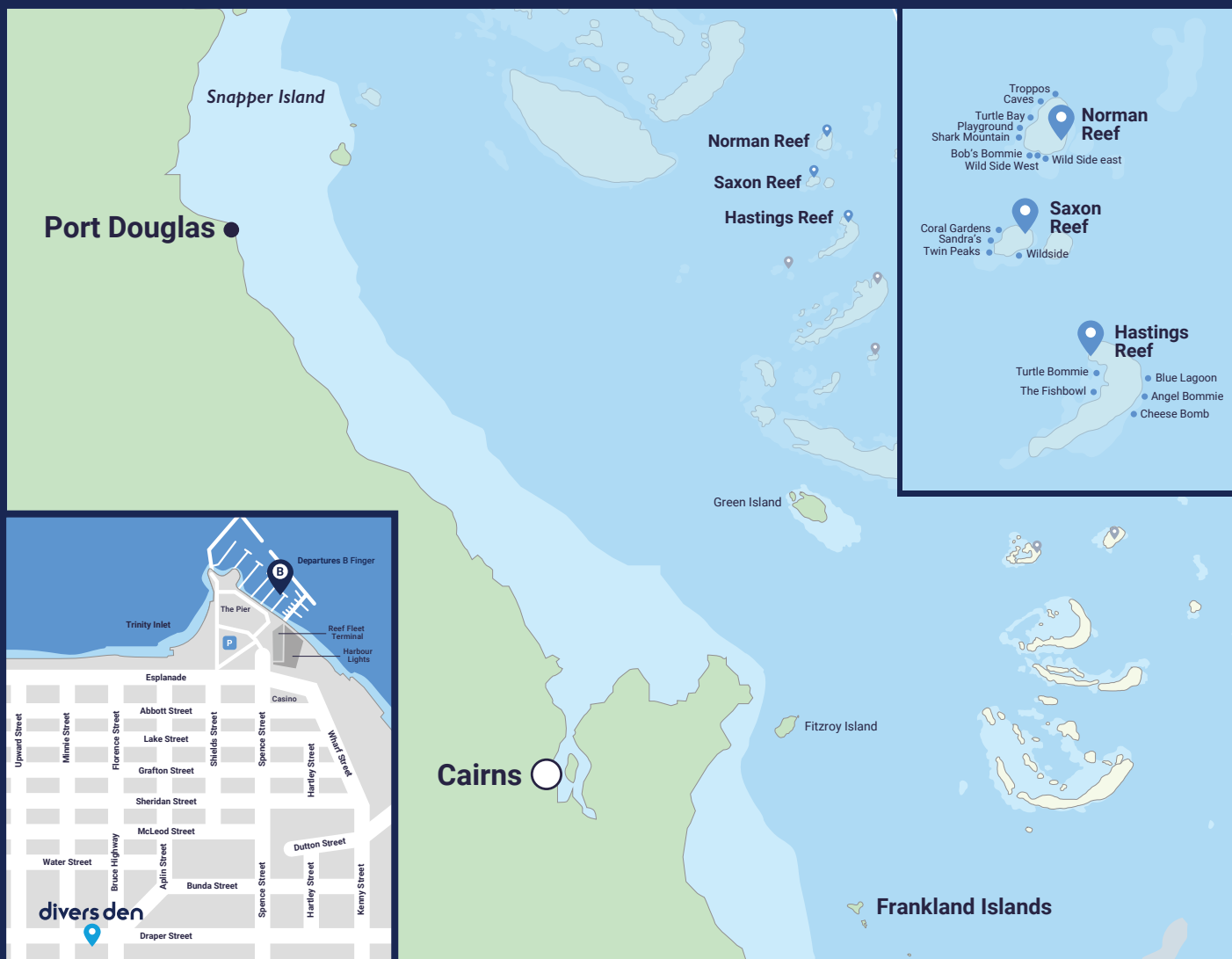

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Medical & Altitude Info

All scuba participants must meet medical questionnaire requirements. Some conditions or medications may prevent you from diving or require a dive medical. Visit diversden.com.au/can-i-dive for more information.

Queensland's code of practice on diving states that for a single no decompression dive, you should not fly/go to altitude for at least 12 hours, or 24 hours if divers have had multiple dives per day for several consecutive days, or have made dives that require decompression stops. Altitude is defined as 300m/1000ft above sea level. This includes going to the Atherton Tablelands (a popular local scenic attraction), so please be aware if booking tours to follow your dive trip. ***Under normal circumstances, you should be out of the water from your last dive of the day at 2:30 pm.***
