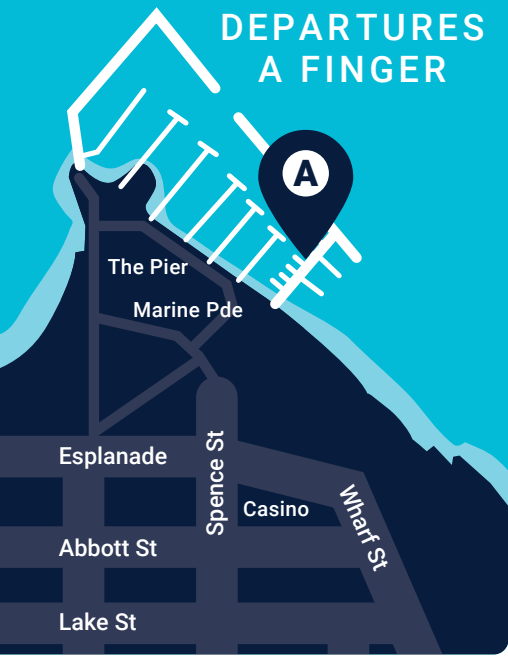

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Cancellations: 100% of the fee will be charged for cancellations received within 24 hours of the travel date. Reasons for cancellations include any factors beyond your/our control, such as medical issues or airline delays. Add on lunch box must be pre-booked at least 24 hours prior to departure. Child age is 4-14yo. Minimum age for Introductory Scuba Dive is 12 years, adult price applies for all ages. Price includes all applicable taxes and levies. Travel insurance is highly recommended. Tusa Reef Tours reserves the right to change vessels, dive locations and fares without notice. Prices valid until 31/03/2027.

MEDICAL & ALTITUDE INFO

All introductory scuba participants must meet medical questionnaire requirements and some conditions or medications may prevent you from diving. Please note, no compensation will be offered if you are unable to complete a pre-booked intro dive. Queensland's code of practice on diving states that for a single no decompression dive, you should not fly/go to altitude for at least 12 hours, or 24 hours if divers have had multiple dives per day for several consecutive days, or have made dives that require decompression stops. Altitude is defined as 300m/1000ft above sea level. This includes going to the Atherton Tablelands (a popular local scenic attraction), so please be aware if booking tours that follow your dive trip. Under normal circumstances, you should be out of the water from your last dive of the day at 12:00 pm.
